





Each year, the United States National Weather Service gives names to hurricanes. The name of the first hurricane of the year begins with A, the second with B, the third with C, and so on, through the letter W. The letters Q and U are <u>not</u> used.

The National Weather Service has 6 lists of hurricane names that they rotate every 6 years. The names of hurricanes that cause a lot of damage, like Hurricane Katrina, are retired. When a name is retired, a new name must be added. Your job is to make a new list of names that could be used when a name is retired. Try to think of a name for each letter.
